



PRICE LIST, TUG CHARLIE

The tugboat's tariffs for merchant vessels in the Port of Raahen area will be charged for each starting half hour based on the vessel's net tonnage, time used and the time of day as follows.

Charge for the tug is from the time the tug boat leaves its base until the time it returns to the base.

The charge shall be made according to the maximum net tonnage of the vessel. In the case of a tug/barge combination or a pusher/barge combination, the towing is charged according to the total net tonnage of the combination.

Minimum charge is always 1 hour.

SEA PASSAGE Transport of persons, delivery of spare parts or similar per tug boat from the order for each starting half hour and pro rata for part thereof.	430

OTHER TERMS

In towing, the tug is using towing line provided from the assisted vessel.

The tug is considered to be under the command of the towed or assisted vessel and the master and crew of the tug boat is considered to be employed by the towed / assisted vessel, so the latter is liable for all costs and damages incurred during the towing / assisted operation to be held accountable.

Rates are per tug. Tariffs are subject to change without prior notice.
